The Cross at the Crossroads

Pike Ave., Exit 159

The Cross at the Crossroads is certainly an engineering wonder, but its greatest miracle is its call to travelers from every faith, background and circumstance, reminding them of the positive values shared and cherished by all.

Soaring nearly 200 feet into the Midwestern sky, The Cross at the Crossroads is a landmark for the over 19 million travelers who pass through Effingham on Interstates 57 and 70 each year.

The Cross includes a Ten Commandments display surrounding the base and a Welcome Center, featuring a chapel, reception area, restrooms, refreshment center and media room where visitors can view a video of the construction and dedication of The Cross.

The Cross at the Crossroads is a project of The Cross Foundation, a not-for-profit organization that strives to offer messages and programs designed to promote the values of faith and family daily living.

The site is host to several community events, including an Easter sunrise and memorial services.

The Welcome Center at The Cross is open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. November to April and 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. May to October.





WE'RE RICH IN HISTORY



EFFINGHAM COUNTY COURTHOUSE

The historic Effingham County Courthouse was built in 1871 on the site of the 1850s courthouse, which tragically burned to the ground in March 1869, reducing most of the county's records to ash.

The courthouse, located on the square in Downtown Effingham, was the fourth one built in Effingham County and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The historical structure was built in Second Empire style and is made of brick, stone and wood with 18-inch outside walls. Special features of the building include stone window headers with keystones above each window and a mansard roof with dormers.

The building was the working courthouse for Effingham County until 2007, when Effingham County constructed a new courthouse two blocks west of this structure. Monuments recognizing the history of the city and county can also be viewed on the lawn surrounding the historic courthouse. According to the Illinois State Historical Society, Effingham was named after General Edward Effingham, an Englishman by birth, who was a United States Surveyor who laid out the county.

The courthouse is the site of special events, including the Artisan Fair, Farmer's Market, Hometown Christmas and the Old Settler's Reunion.

EFFINGHAM COUNTY COURTHOUSE MUSEUM

The Effingham County Cultural Center and Museum Association came into existence as the result of a desire to promote interpretive culture and history as a means of increasing public awareness of the history of Effingham County and the National Road.

The Effingham County Courthouse Museum features two rooms devoted to a specific military experience, which changes throughout the year. The second floor features a courtroom that is available for events.

The Courthouse Museum also has a room dedicated to transportation and the railroads in Effingham County. The exhibit features various railroad artifacts throughout time.

The museum is open on Tuesdays and Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. March through December. The museum is closed to the general public January and February, except for special programming or by appointment. Donations are appreciated.

EFFINGHAM COUNTY VETERAN'S MEMORIAL

On Veteran's Day, November 11, 1991, the first three stones of the Memorial were dedicated in honor of all Effingham County veterans. The "Memorial Names Stone" addition was dedicated on Armed Forces Day, May 19, 2012. This memorial has close to 3.700 names of men and women veterans from all five branches of the armed forces. The stones were designed and etched with the past, present and future in mind. Each year, more names can and will be added. It is an ongoing memorial with space for over 9,000 names.

The Memorial is not only a tribute, it is our history: a standing memorial to the living and the dead, our neighbors, families and friends, who have served to preserve, protect and secure peace for our nation. Some served on foreign shores, some within our own borders, some died, some never saw action, some were drafted and some enlisted. All served. All gave themselves to our country. We are forever thankful for their sacrifice.

DR. CHARLES M. WRIGHT HOUSE MUSEUM

Described as a time capsule, this 18-room historic home features the furnishings and collections of three generations of the Wright family. Listed in the National Register of Historic Places, the 1889 home was built by one of the first medical doctors in Altamont. The selfsufficient home had indoor plumbing, central heating and gaslights in 1889. The second generation to live in the home was his son who practiced medicine for 65 years in Altamont. Charles M. Wright III was a lawyer for Shell Oil until retirement when he moved into his family home. At his death, the home was left in a trust to be preserved and maintained.

MONASTERY MUSEUM

The museum is a prism into the history of the settlers of the Teutopolis region and the Franciscans who ministered to them. View a dazzling panorama of the early life in this German Catholic community, founded in 1838, and the multitude of religious artifacts left by the Franciscans who first arrived in 1858.

The three priests and six brothers who arrived in 1858 set about building a parish and friary. Today, that monastery houses the antique Bibles, hand-scribed books and hundreds of other items representative of daily religious life.The furnishings, clothing, toys, utensils and elaborate documents on display are works of art in themselves. These artifacts offer a poignant and amazingly complete look at the lives of Teutopolis' first residents.

This non-denominational City cemetery is the final resting place of many fascinating figures from Effingham's stories of the past.

Ada Kepley, the first female law graduate in the United States, was an ardent advocate of women's rights and friend of Susan B. Anthony. She published a newspaper and wrote books and songs. Mrs. Kepley was also a zealous prohibitionist, whose numerous detractors chafed at her activism. One was even driven to make an attempt on her life!

Lying in wait for the Kepleys to return home late one night, the perpetrator shot at but missed Mrs. Kepley as she ascended the stairs to her downtown home. Mrs. Kepley was not unscathed, as unfortunately, the shot hit her dog.

President Grant offered Col. John J. Funkhouser, a Civil War veteran, the office of Secretary of War, but he

established a collection of works that is available at the Effingham Public Library located at 200 N. Third St. Members of the Genealogy Society are available from 10 a.m. to noon on Wednesdays and Saturdays to assist those exploring the history of our region.

declined. He later became the first mayor of Effingham. Col. Funkhouser's father. Senator Preslev Funkhouser. had considerable influence in the decision to move the county seat from from Ewington to Effingham, spelling the demise of Ewington.



A monument honoring Ada and husband, Henry Kepley, stands at the location where their home once stood. Mary (Mother) Newcomb came to Effingham during the Civil War after her husband, Hiram, enlisted in the 11th Illinois Infantry. She was 44 years old at the time.

After Hiram was wounded in battle, Mary brought her husband back to Effingham, but he died shortly after on February 26, 1862. Fulfilling his dying wish, Mary returned to the regiment to nurse the sick and wounded soldiers until the end of the war. Mary visited the White House and had a visit on the porch with Mr. Lincoln.

Another resident with a strong Lincoln connection was Catherine (Katie) McPherson Kelly Clutter, who was born in Washington D.C. Katie remained in Washington D.C. while her husband, Tom Kelly, was on detached duty during the Civil War. Katie–a personal friend of Mary Todd Lincoln–frequently cared for "Little Tad." Tom Kelly died in 1876, and in 1879, Katie married Noah D. Clutter of Effingham.

HEART THEATER 133 E. Jefferson Ave., Exit 159/162

Across the street from the old courthouse is the Heart Theater, a 1930s landmark. The theater is one of two examples in Effingham of the Art Deco style that was popular from 1920 to 1940. The cream and maroon terra-cotta tiles are a perfect foil for the neon and marquee lights.



NATIONAL ROAD

It was a superhighway of dirt, rock and timber. In 1806, President Thomas Jefferson signed legislation creating a National Road funded solely by the federal government, a first at the time.

With westward expansion on the lips of a nation busting at the seams, this road would provide a route from Cumberland, Maryland to Pennsylvania, Virginia (later West Virginia), Ohio, Indiana and Illinois. Because of its point of origin, it was often referred to as the Cumberland Trail, although other popular names included the National Pike, the National Trail and the National Road.

The National Road rose from the transportation scrapbook to become the blueprint for an ocean-to-ocean route known as U.S. Route 40.

Today, the Illinois National Road stretches 164 miles from the Indiana border to the Mississippi River in East St. Louis and encompasses seven counties: Clark, Cumberland, Effingham, Fayette, Bond, Madison and St. Clair. Many of the communities owe its origin to the National Road, bringing the settlers that turned prairieland to civilization.


The National Road Association of Illinois is currently busy promoting the unique attractions the road offers. An "Art & Architecture" guidebook was created to highlight the art and architectural treasures located in communities along the National Road. In addition, the National Road Association has recently completed the kiosk project.

This project includes 21 kiosks placed in 21 communities along the Illinois National Road. The kiosks provide an overview of the National Road history and timeline, a map of the National Road and individual community history that includes local sites of interest.

Effingham's kiosk sits on the grounds of the Effingham County Courthouse Museum. Also, look for the children's story by National Road enthusiast Molly Bellamey, called *Patch on the National Road*. You can pick up this book at the Effingham Visitor Center and Vandalia National Road Interpretive Center.

The Illinois National Road Association promotes the roadway and activities on the roadway.


